

Return to Play Guidelines – 6.16.20***Swope Soccer Village***

(6.12.20) -- As of yesterday, per Governor Parson, the state of Missouri will enter phase 2 of its reopening plan beginning this Tuesday, June 16. Organized sport facilities and practices continue to be allowed with limitations. Below are the Return to Play Guidelines – 6.16.20.

Requirements:

- Players and coaches will be the only people allowed within the green fence that borders the playing fields. Parents/guardians, siblings, etc. may stay in cars, stand along the fence, walk/run around the perimeter of the facility, etc.
- Social distancing must take place off the field. This includes players/coaches on the sidelines & parents/guardians/siblings/etc. during their visit to the facility.
- Activities are to be limited to no more than 45 people per field. This includes players and coaches.
- Activities are to be limited to 2 hours with a 15-minute break in between activities on each field. Start/end times should be staggered to ensure no more than half the facility is changing over at any given time.
- Games and scrimmages may be played with modified rules to discourage contact.
- Each renting organization must keep an internal record (date and time) of which teams/players/coaches are at the facility throughout this phase.
- Each renting organization must abide by its insurance providers' return to play guidelines. Insurance providers may include Missouri Youth Soccer, US Club Soccer, Say Soccer, etc.

Recommendations:

- Continue to follow proper precautions (i.e. wash/sanitize hands, stay home if sick, avoid touching of face, wear a mask, etc.).
- Do not share sports equipment.
- Vulnerable populations should be asked to stay home.
- If a positive COVID-19 case occurs within your organization, please report the case to SF+A. This will help us contact trace and allow us to warn all individuals who may be at risk.
